

For those of us who were privileged to be involved in the West Yorkshire Destitute Asylum Network Project, it was an awesome experience! Some would say it was a very short-term fix but for those men they had food, warmth and shelter for the week with us and continued on to other churches. One individual said it was good just to hear laughter.

Outside my window at this mo-

ment in time it is pouring with rain. For those who have no choice but to sleep outside tonight, our hearts bleed for them. Please remember them in your prayers. There are organisations that work tirelessly to support the homeless, the needy, the poor. Please support where you can.

There are 3.7 million children living in homes struggling to afford enough meat, food and vegetables. Foodbanks are bursting at the seams with requests for help. 4 million children live below the poverty line, even though at least one member of the household is employed. 
